## HHVBP Reports

### Office > HHVBP Report

- From the Main Menu in Barnestorm Office click the Patient Histories tab.
- From the sub-category click the HHVBP tab.
- Select the fourth tab at the top HHVBP Report.

## HHVBP Reports

### Office > HHVBP Report

- There are two audit reports you can run to see if there are any patient's with a transfer/discharge/death OASIS that have not had Shingles or ACP data keyed in yet. Both reports will look for patients who meet the HHVBP criteria AND has had one or more transfer/death/discharge OASIS during the reporting period.
- Check the Missing Data Only bullet and then click on either the Shingles or ACP button at the bottom.
- Select Flu Vaccine to audit employees with missing data.
- We recommend running these reports and updating data as needed before printing your quarterly report.

## HHVBP Reports

### Office > HHVBP Report

- Check the Completed Data Only bullet to view patient's that meet the HHVBP criteria and have a transfer/death/discharge OASIS keyed
- Click the Shingles or ACP button to view the patient's that have data keyed into Barnestorm for the current reporting period

## HHVBP Reports

### Office > HHVBP Report

- The HHVBP New Measures report will run your **quarterly report** counts that need to be submitted through the HHVBP secure portal.
- Use the -1 Quarter and +1 Quarter buttons to toggle between quarterly dates.
- Counts include patients who had a transfer/discharge/death OASIS for the reporting period AND has the new measures data completed.
- If a patient has multiple transfers in a reporting period then each set is counted.
- For each transfer/discharge/death OASIS keyed, the system looks for the closest set of answers.

## HHVBP Reports

### Office > HHVBP Report

- Use the HHVBP New Measures Compare Last 4 Quarters button to pull up the data of the most recent quarters, based on the dates you have selected.
- Select the quarter you want to end on and select the Compare Last 4 Quarters button.

### Office > HHVBP Report

- After you have ran the audit reports and fixed any issues, print the quarterly report.
- Log into the HHVBP secure portal and follow their directions on how to submit data.
