## Invalid Medicine Name: Medicine Not Found in Database

The medication is in the database, but "errors" when I try to discontinue it or make changes.



- 1. Select the patient
- 2. Select Patient Histories tab
- 3. Select Med History tab
- 4. Click on the medication
- 5. Select Edit Incorrect Entry tab
- 6. On the right, under "Fix Med Name." (*This only appears if the medication is not in the database.*), *e*nter the correct name (or first 3 letters) into the white area, and options will appear.

- 7. Click on the correct spelling of the medication. (As you can see "Clindamycin Phosphate" is not included in the list.) The medicine name should now appear in the white area.
- 8. Click Fix
- 9. If needed, uncheck the **Show / Hide Med Builder** button to make the dose/freq show up.
- 10. Click Save and Exit
